**Important notes:**

- 1- Class size in the summer program will be maximum 25 students. So registration will be first come first serve.
- 2- All returned checks will be charged a \$30 return fee per check.
- 3- Class Assignments - Classes are assigned by the summer school administrative team based on enrollment, need, and the availability of experienced teachers. Courses that are canceled due to insufficient enrollment or lack of experience teachers will result in a full refund or the opportunity for the student to select another available course.
- 4- Attendance Policy - Efficient use of class time is essential to the student's success. Students will be withdrawn without receiving credit for the course if they have more than two (2) absences during a session, regardless of the date of the third absence. A student is marked absent after missing the first 30 minutes of a class. Three tardy slips in a class will be counted as one (1) absence.
- 5- Students are expected to follow guidelines in the HPS Student Handbook. Students may wear free dress, but must follow appropriate free dress and grooming guidelines in HPS student handbook.
- 6- Students will earn credit by demonstrating a minimum of 70% mastery of the course TEKS as defined by the course syllabus.
- 7- Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for excessive absences/tardiness or who are withdrawn for dress and grooming violations or who are withdrawn for discipline reasons.
- 8- Refunds will not be given once classes begin on the first day of each summer school session.
